



4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 22ND JUNE, 2025

THEME: THE SPIRIT EMPOWERMENT

BELIEVER

READING: PSALM 95:1-7; I SAMUEL 7:4-16; 1 PETER 2:1-10; JOHN 15:1-5.

It is with great joy that I welcome you again into another new week and the first Sunday after Trinity, it is my prayers that the Trinity will visit you and all your interests at the point of their

need this week in Jesus name (Amen).

The topic this morning discusses one of the natures or characteristics of a Christian, which is the spirit empowered believer. To be empowered by the Spirit is to receive the Holy Spirit and also to be enabled or activated or strengthened or energized or fired up by the Holy Spirit. A Spirit empowered believer is someone who has received the Holy Spirit and is enabled by that Spirit to live a life that is pleasing to God and also impactful for the kingdom of God. The workings of the Holy Spirit in the life of a believer are not only internal (within), they are also external (without), and this is because the evidences of enablement must be shown in our good works to others around us and for His kingdom.

The life of a believer is not a confused life; every stage of the believer's life is with significance. Before one can be said to be Spirit empowered, there must have an encounter with the Lord (John 3:16) it is that encounter that culminates in relationship with the Holy Spirit which also led to the baptism of the Holy Spirit. It's a process and once a believer yields himself or herself to the dictates of the Word of God, the Holy Spirit indwells him or her. The Spirit of the Lord is a gift from God and the Bible refers to Him as a seal of promise (Ephesian 1:13), it is his indwelling in us that leads to regeneration or being born again.

WHAT DOES THE EMPOWERMENT OF THE HOLY SPIRIT DO THE BELIEVERS?

There are different ways the empowerment of the Holy Spirit helps the believers but the major ones are explained below:

- 1. The Holy Spirit gives the believers sufficient grace for Christian living: the Holy Spirit empowers believers to live a life that reflects the character of Christ. This includes living righteously, practicing love and exhibiting other fruits of the Spirit.
- 2. It is also the empowerment of the Holy Spirit that destroys the zeal or desire for sin in the lives of a believer: the nature of sin indwells all of us(Romans 3:23), but the Holy Spirit's empowerment in us kills that drive and helps us to desire the things of God and those things that pleases Him always.
- 3. The empowerment of the Holy Spirit helps us to resist temptations and fleshly lusts: every single has its own tempting moments, but the empowerment of the Holy Spirit gives us constraint and caution at all times.
- 4. The Holy Spirit empowers us for service: it is through the empowerment of the Holy Spirit that believers yield themselves unto the Service of the Lord. The Holy Spirit equips believers with spiritual gifts for the common good of the Church and to advance the kingdom of God. These gifts include wisdom, knowledge, faith, healing, discernment, prophecy among several others.
- 5. The Holy Spirit empowers believers for witness: the empowerment of the Holy Spirit is what makes believers bold to share their faith and be witnesses to Christ even in the face of several hardships. Numerous examples are found in the book of the Acts of the Apostles where the disciples of Jesus Christ preached the gospel with power and signs following them.

In Conclusion, it is important to note that the empowerment of the Holy Spirit is not a one-time event but an ongoing
