4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 3RD AUGUST, 2025

THEME: ARE YOU LED BY THE SPIRIT OR

THE FLESH?

READING: PSALM 119:49-64; EZEKIEL 36:24 -

28;GALATIANS 5:16-26;

LUKE 6:27-38.

Introduction: The Battle Within

All glory, honour and majesty to our God who has given us the privilege to witness another Sunday. May His name be praised forever in Jesus name. Amen. Every believer walks a daily path marked by choices, that reveal the inner workings of our heart and the influence guiding us. Paul, writing to the Galatians, outlines a stark contrast between two ways of life: one that is led by the **Spirit of God**, and another driven by the **flesh**, or sinful nature. These two forces are in constant opposition.

The Works of the Flesh: A Path to Destruction

When we are controlled by the flesh, our lives begin to manifest behaviors that are contrary to God's nature and design. Paul calls these "works of the flesh," and they include:

- **Moral impurities**: adultery, fornication, lewdness
- **Spiritual corruption**: idolatry, sorcery
- Relational breakdowns: hatred, jealousy, outbursts of anger, selfish ambitions, divisions
- **Personal recklessness**: drunkenness, envy, revelries

These behaviors are not just mistakes, they are signs of a life out of alignment with God's will. Paul warns that "those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God" (Gal. 5:21). This is a serious reminder that unchecked sin has eternal consequences.

The Fruit of the Spirit: A Life That Glorifies God

In contrast, when we walk in the Spirit, our lives begin to bear **fruit** — evidence of God's nature within us. This fruit is not something we manufacture on our own, but the natural result of abiding in Christ and yielding to His Spirit daily. "But the fruit of the Spirit is **love**, **joy**, **peace**, **longsuffering**, **kindness**, **goodness**, **faithfulness**, **gentleness**, **self-control**." – *Galatians* 5:22–23. This fruit reflects the **character of Jesus** and testifies to others that we belong to Him.

The Inner Conflict: Spirit vs. Flesh

Paul explains that the **flesh and the Spirit are at war within us** (Gal. 5:17). This means believers must live with spiritual awareness. The flesh wants immediate gratification, rebellion, and independence from God. The Spirit calls us to patience, obedience, and submission to God's will.

You cannot live by both. **To walk in the Spirit requires crucifying the flesh,** putting to death its desires by the power of the Holy Spirit (Gal. 5:24).

What Does It Mean to Walk in the Spirit?

Walking in the Spirit is more than avoiding sin; it is actively pursuing intimacy with God. It means:

- **Surrendering daily** to God's control
- **Listening** for the Spirit's leading in decisions
- **Obeying** the Word even when it costs
- **Desiring holiness** over comfort

It is a life of **relationship**, not just rules. When we walk in the Spirit, we don't have to strive to be good, we simply abide, and fruit grows naturally (John 15:5).

Practical Ways to Be Led by the Spirit.

- **a) Start Your Day with God:** Before the demands of the day crowd in, take time to pray and ask the Holy Spirit to guide your thoughts, words, and actions. *Psalm 5:3, Proverbs 3:5-6.*
- **b) Stay in the Word:** Let Scripture renew your mind and align your desires with God's. Without the Word, your heart will drift toward the flesh. *Psalm 119:11, 2 Timothy 3:16-17*.
- **c) Guard Your Heart:** Be mindful of what you consume, music, conversations, media. What you allow in will influence whether the flesh or the Spirit leads. *Proverbs 4:23, Philippians 4:8*.
- **d) Practice Obedience:** When you feel a nudge in your spirit, to forgive, to speak truth, to avoid sin, obey quickly. Delayed obedience empowers the flesh. *James 1:22, John 14:15*.
- **e) Walk in Community:** Surround yourself with believers who sharpen and challenge you to grow in godliness (Proverbs 27:17).

Conclusion

There's no middle ground. You are either being led by the flesh or by the Spirit. But here's the hope: **The Spirit is willing.** If you invite Him in, He will empower you, transform you, and bear fruit in you that blesses not only your life but everyone around you. "If we live in the Spirit, let us also walk in the Spirit." – *Galatians 5:25*
