

# 4. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 6<sup>TH</sup> JULY, 2025

THEME: THE DANGERS OF MATERIALISM PSALM 63:1-11; DEUTERONOMY 7:6
-11; GALATIANS 3:23-4:7; MATTHEW

6:24-34.

Materialism is the excessive focus on material possessions, wealth, and physical comfort, often placing them above spiritual values. It is attractive to the eyes and subtly convinces many to live as though material things are the essence of life. When our affection for material gain overshadows God's will and intentions for us, it becomes a dangerous path.

One major root of materialism is identity crisis. Many chase after possessions because they do not truly know who they are in Christ. Yet, God, our loving Father, is the Creator and owner of all things. As Jesus teaches in Matthew 6:26–30, if God provides for the birds of the air and clothes the lilies of the field, how much more will He care for His children?

The problem is that many are not rightly positioned as children of God. But once we are in Christ, we become God's sons and daughters—heirs and joint-heirs with Christ (Galatians 3:26–4:7). This gives us access to God's provision without striving like the world does. To overcome materialism, we must resolve the crisis of identity by embracing the life of God through Christ and allowing His Spirit to rule our hearts (Matthew 6:24).

#### DANGERS OF MATERIALISM

#### 1. It severs intimacy with God


When material cravings become intense, our relationship with God begins to suffer. Even someone as close to God as Moses would lose intimacy if materialism ruled his heart.

#### 2. It diminishes reverence for God's Word

People consumed by material desires gradually develop an over-familiar attitude toward God's Word. They begin to twist Scriptures to justify worldly pursuits, eventually drifting from truth.

It breeds anxiety and discontentment

Materialism never satisfies; instead, it fuels constant craving for more. This endless cycle



#### 4. <u>It weakens trust in God's provision</u>

When we prioritize wealth, we tend to rely on our efforts rather than God's faithfulness. This undermines our faith and makes us more vulnerable to fear and greed.

#### <u>HOW TO AVOID THE TRAPS OF</u> MATERIALISM

#### 1. Seek God relentlessly

"But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness, and all these things shall be added to you." (Matthew 6:33; Psalm 63:1)

#### 2. Love God unconditionally

"Know therefore that the Lord your God is God; He is the faithful God, keeping His covenant of love to a thousand generations of those who love Him..." (Deuteronomy 7:9)

# 3. <u>Walk in obedience to God's commandments</u>

"Therefore, be careful to follow the commands, decrees and laws I give you today." (Deuteronomy 7:11)

#### 4. <u>Practice contentment</u>

"Godliness with contentment is great gain." (1 Timothy 6:6) A content heart safeguards the soul from the lust for more.

#### **Conclusion:**

Materialism is a choice. As humans, we are free to choose, but our choices have consequences. Let your desires be shaped by God's interest, not worldly pressure. Choose the path that brings
