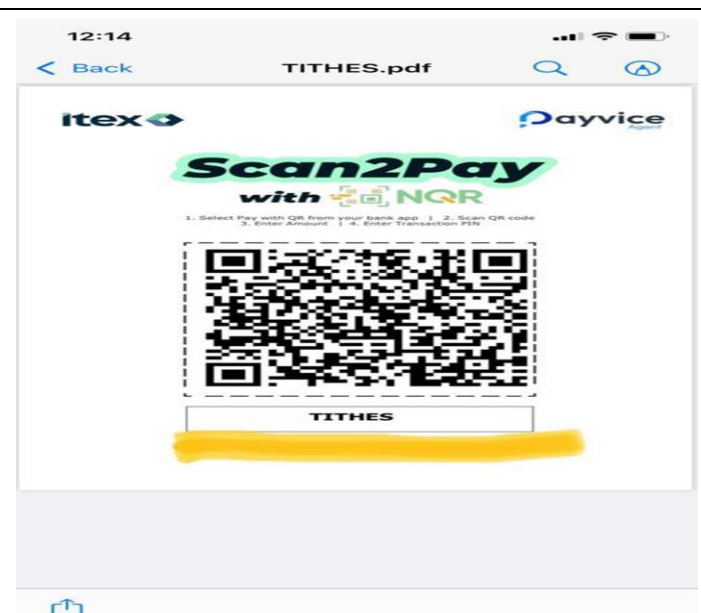

SUNDAY, 17TH AUGUST, 2025**

**THEME: ENCOURAGING THE LEADER
AND THE LED IN THE CHURCH
TODAY**

READING: PSALM 119:81-96; PROVERBS 7:7-10; I PETER 5:1-11; MATTHEW 18:1-16.

In the name of the Lord Jesus Christ, you are welcome once again into the presence of God. May He answer all your prayers according to His will. This week shall be a productive one for you and your family, in Jesus' name.

Introduction

Encouraging both church leaders and members is essential to building a healthy Christian community. Scripture calls them to walk together in mutual respect, genuine love, and shared accountability (Ephesians 4:2-3). Leaders are to embrace a spirit of servant leadership, guiding with humility, integrity, and compassion. Members, in turn, are called to submit willingly to godly authority while actively participating in the life and mission of the church. When both the leader and the led faithfully honour their God-given roles, the church flourishes as a vibrant family where Christ is glorified and His work advances.

Encouraging the Leader in the Church today

- **Protect and Support.** Church members must take an active role in protecting their leaders from attacks, temptations, and spiritual burnout. Leaders often face significant pressures, and without the prayer, encouragement, and practical support of their congregation, they can become vulnerable to discouragement or even moral failure. Protecting a leader means covering them in prayer, offering encouragement, and guarding them from needless criticism. As **Hebrews 13:17** reminds us, believers are called to obey their leaders and submit to their authority, recognizing that they keep watch over souls and will give an account. Such support not only strengthens leaders but also blesses the entire church.
- **Honour and Willing Submission.** A place of leadership is a place of honor. Members must also honor and respect their leaders (1 Thessalonians 5:12-13). It means honoring their God-given authority and treating them with dignity.
- **Lifting Leaders in Prayer.** Members must faithfully pray for their leaders, for they carry a heavy burden of responsibility and need God's strength to stand firm. Paul frequently requested prayers from the churches he led (1 Thessalonians 5:25). Praying for leaders helps them remain spiritually strong, make wise decisions, and lead with integrity.

- Generosity as a Mark of Honour. Leaders need genuine appreciation for their ministry, through kind words, thoughtful gifts, and care for their families, fulfilling a biblical mandate and bringing mutual blessing (Matthew 10:42).

Encouraging the led in the church today

1. Serving with God's given gifts. In 1 Peter 4:10 we read, "As each has received a gift, use it to serve one another, as good stewards of God's varied grace". God has taken the time to design each of us with specific gifts and talents. These gifts are not meant to be used for our own personal gain, but used for His Kingdom. We use what He has given us to be part of His Kingdom work.
2. Serving in God's greater purpose. Paul, in 1 Corinthians, gives us the description of being part of the "body". Like the human body, there are many parts. Each part has its specific role. However, that part does not function to serve itself, but rather functions as part of the greater organism. As part of the Body of Christ, we have this amazing opportunity to use our gifts as part of something bigger than ourselves. No gift is too small. No gift is insignificant. No gift is meaningless, because all gifts are from God.
3. Stepping up as Laborers for Christ. In learning how to encourage church members to serve and be Kingdom Laborers, it's important to keep this in mind. When we serve, we get to show others the powerful love of Jesus.
4. Strengthening others through support (*1 Thessalonians 5:11*). Say something positive to the people around you about who they are or how much you appreciate them. Or tell them how much God loves them and wants to bless them. Encouragement is powerful. It makes people feel better in every way.

In conclusion, while much attention is often given to the responsibility of leaders to guide, teach, and care for their members, the equally vital role of members in supporting, protecting, and upholding their leaders must not be overlooked. Church members are not merely passive recipients of ministry but active partners in ensuring their leaders remain strong, accountable, and effective in fulfilling their God-given calling. A culture of encouragement, not criticism, can transform a church (Hebrews 10:24–25), as leaders and members appreciate one another's strengths over weaknesses.
