

4. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 24TH AUGUST, 2025**

THEME: WORKING TOGETHER AS TEAM MEMBERS

**READING: PSALM 119:97-112;
1 CHRONICLES 29:1-9;
ACTS 2:41-47; MATTHEW 25:31-46.**

The early church as recorded in Acts 2:41–42 provides a remarkable example of teamwork and unity in the body of Christ. After Peter's Spirit-filled sermon on the Day of Pentecost, about three thousand souls were converted. These new believers did not scatter to live individualistic Christian lives but *"continued steadfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, in the breaking of bread, and in prayers."* This picture reveals that growth, strength, and spiritual depth in the church are the results of believers working together as one team.

Teamwork is deeply rooted in the Word of God. Ecclesiastes 4:9–10 affirms, *"Two are better than one, because they have a good reward for their labour. For if they fall, the one will lift up his fellow."* The principle is clear: collaboration multiplies effectiveness and provides mutual support. Paul echoes this truth in 1 Corinthians 3:9: "For we are labourers together with God." As members of Christ's body, we complement; not compete with; one another (1 Corinthians 12:12–27).

Jesus Himself prayed for the unity of believers in John 17:21: "That they all may be one; as thou, Father, art in me, and I in thee, that they also may be one in us: that the world may believe that thou hast sent me." Thus, teamwork is not just a convenient method; it is a divine mandate for the Church.

Benefits of Unity

1. **Strength and Growth** – When believers are united, they experience spiritual strength. Psalm 133:1–3 declares, "Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity! ... for there the Lord commanded the blessing." Unity invites divine blessing and accelerates church growth.
2. **Effective Witness** – A united church sends a powerful testimony to the world about God's love (John 13:35). Unity strengthens evangelism. This creates an attractive picture that fascinates people outside the world to join the church.
3. **Mutual Support** – Teamwork ensures that burdens are shared, and victories are celebrated together (Galatians 6:2). This fosters a situation where everyone is looking for the good of everyone.

4. **Multiplication of Effort** – Leviticus 26:8 reminds us, “Five of you shall chase a hundred, and a hundred of you shall put ten thousand to flight.” Unity multiplies impact. The unity of the early was what led to the multiplication effect in the number of worshippers.

Detriments of Disunity

1. **Weakening of the Body** – Jesus warned in Mark 3:25: “If a house be divided against itself, that house cannot stand.” Disunity drains strength and hinders progress of the church.
2. **Loss of Focus** – When team members fight among themselves, they shift attention away from the mission to petty issues, just as the Corinthian church was distracted by divisions (1 Corinthians 1:10–12). Disunity is one of the tools used by the enemy to make the church lose focus.
3. **Absence of God’s Blessing** – Where disunity thrives, God’s commanded blessing is withheld (Psalm 133:3). In fact, God does not stay in an atmosphere of rancor and disagreement.
4. **Poor Witness to the World** – A divided church repels seekers rather than attracting them. Instead of testifying to Christ’s love, it broadcasts strife.

Causes of Disunity

1. **Pride and Selfish Ambition** – James 3:16 says, “For where envying and strife is, there is confusion and every evil work.” Pride causes individuals to seek recognition instead of service.
2. **Doctrinal Errors** – False teachings or distorted interpretations of Scripture often divide the church (Galatians 1:6–9).
3. **Unforgiveness** – When offenses are not resolved, bitterness grows, and fellowship is destroyed (Ephesians 4:31–32).
4. **Lack of Love** – Where genuine love is absent, unity cannot thrive (Colossians 3:14).
5. **Poor Leadership** – Leaders who fail to foster inclusiveness, humility, and vision often create division.

To work effectively as team members, believers must cultivate humility, patience, and mutual respect. Paul instructs in Philippians 2:2–4: “Fulfil ye my joy, that ye be likeminded, having the same love, being of one accord of one mind. Let nothing be done through strife or vainglory; but in lowliness of mind let each esteem other better than themselves.” This spirit of humility strengthens unity. Teamwork requires recognizing and celebrating diversity of gifts within the body (Romans 12:4–6). Not everyone will teach, sing, or lead, but every gift matters. Just as a body cannot function with one part, the church cannot thrive without every member playing their role.

Conclusion

Working together as team members is God’s design for His people. Unity brings growth, blessing, strength, and effective witness, while disunity weakens the body, diminishes progress, and harms the church’s testimony. Believers must therefore guard against pride, unforgiveness, and doctrinal strife while striving for love, humility, and common purpose. As John Maxwell rightly observed, “Teamwork makes the dream work, but a vision becomes a nightmare when the leader has a big dream and a bad team.” May the Church always remain a team united in Christ, so that the world will see His glory through us.
