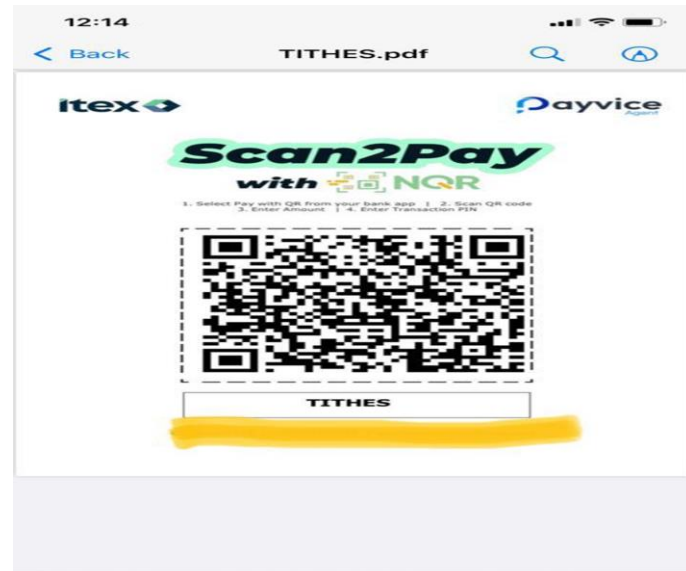

SUNDAY, 31ST AUGUST, 2025**

THEME: NEW LIFE IN CHRIST

READING: PSALM 119:113-128; ISAIAH 49:1-6;
II CORINTHIANS 5:14-6:2;
JOHN 17:20-26.

INTRODUCTION

Today is an important day in our church where in we celebrate with thanksgiving to God three things.

Firstly, It's the last Sunday in the month August, the last day of the month as well and the Youth Harvest! It's a delight to witness another gathering of believers as we celebrate Gods faithfulness.

However, it will be sweeter and more spirit filled if we all epitomize the life of Christ and perform as occasion demands of us! **ARE YOU LIVING A NEW LIFE IN CHRIST?** Of what use is our gathering and Christianity when our life doesn't portray it? Does your reference and aura today in church match that which is expressed at home, work and neighborhood?

That is where we should start from in this short homily.

THE CALL TO BELIEVERS.

Beloved, every true believer is called not just to believe in Christ but to live a life in Christ and for Christ. Jesus, in His high priestly prayer (John 17), prayed that all believers may be one with Him and with the Father, sharing in His glory and love. Paul reminds us in 2 Corinthians 5:16 that we should no longer view Christ or anyone according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit, because in Christ we have become a new creation.

Moreover, The Christian faith is not about turning over a new leaf, it is about receiving a new life. Paul shows us in this passage that being in Christ changes everything: how we see, who we are, and what we live for.

WHAT IS THIS NEW LIFE?

1. **A Life that Reflects Christ (2 Corinthians 5:16)** Paul says we no longer see Christ or others in a worldly way. A life of Christ is marked by a new perspective—we don't live in selfishness, pride, or worldly values anymore. Instead, people should see Christ's character in our actions: His humility, His compassion, His forgiveness. The measure of a believer's life is not titles, wealth, or success, but how much of Christ people can see in us.

7.

2. New Life Gives Us a New Perspective (v.16)“So from now on we regard no one from a worldly point of view.”In Christ, our way of seeing people changes.No longer by race, tribe, class, or achievements, but through the eyes of God’s love.New life helps us see others as souls Christ died for.It also changes how we see Christ—not just as a teacher or prophet, but as Lord and Saviour.

3. New Life Brings Reconciliation with God (vv.18–19) “God... reconciled us to Himself through Christ.”

Our greatest problem was separation from God because of sin.In Christ, we are forgiven, restored, and brought into a relationship with God.But reconciliation is not for us alone—we are given the ministry of reconciliation. New life in Christ is not silent; it shares the good news with others.

4. New Life Makes Us Ambassadors for Christ (vv.20–21)“We are therefore Christ’s ambassadors...”

An ambassador represents their country faithfully in a foreign land. As Christians, our citizenship is in heaven, but we live on earth as Christ’s representatives. People should encounter Christ through our words, character, and love. This is possible because “God made him who had no sin to be sin for us, so that in him we might become the righteousness of God.”Our new life rests on the exchange of the cross—Christ took our sin, and we received His righteousness.

CONCLUSION

Beloved, if you are in Christ, you are not who you used to be. The past is gone, a new life has begun. Live it to glorify Christ. Beloved, this is the call of every Christian: to let Christ live in us and through us, until the world sees Him in our lives.

Finally brethren, let us meditate on this word as we align our heart and soul to Him

It is no longer I who live, but Christ lives in me; and the life I now live in the flesh I live by faith in the Son of God, who loved me and gave Himself for me.” – Galatians 2:20
