8. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 21ST SEPTEMBER, 2025

THEME: MEANINGFULLY SHARING WITH THE NEEDY
READING: PSALM 119:161-176; LEVITICUS 19:33-37; 1 CORINTHIANS 13:1-13; LUKE 10:25-37.

In the name of our Lord Jesus Christ, you are welcome once again into the sanctuary of the Lord and it is my prayers that the Lord will visit you this Sunday and make this new week your week of celebrations in the name of Jesus Christ.

The topic which we are dealing with this morning is very dear to God because He is always concerned about the needy and their wellbeing. The Bible is full of several references that support this claim and some of them are; Psalm 82:3 speaking about defending the weak; Psalm 140:12 reiterating God's justice for the poor; Proverbs 14:31, Deuteronomy 15:7-8, Proverbs 19:17, Luke 12:33, Acts 20:35, 2 Corinthians 9:7 and Hebrews 13:16 among others making reference to showing kindness to the needy or helping the poor. To share with the needy is a constant practice or lifestyle of the church (Acts 4:32-35) and it is also the heartbeat that makes the Church a living community.

By definition, the word “needy” refers to individuals or groups who lack essential resources such as financial supports, food, shelter, clothing or health care among several others. Other synonyms for the needy are the poor, the impoverished, the disadvantaged and the vulnerable.

A meaningful sharing with the needy is not just an act of charity; it is an investment in God's kingdom and whoever aligns with that practice is doing so to his or her advantage.

To share meaningfully with the needy entails providing assistance, support or resources to those who require them, to either meet their basic needs or to improve their wellbeing. This is more than just financial support; it includes showing empathy, kindness and understanding to the vulnerable or the disadvantaged. It is expedient for us to note that anytime we share with the needy, we are reflecting the character of God, but if we fail to do it, especially when we are prompted to do so, then we are disobedient children.

The blessings of meaningfully sharing with the needy include; God showing you mercy, giving you safety, providing for your own needs, giving you peace, eternal rewards, defending you and also using your seeds of kindness as a witness for bringing others to Christ.

In conclusion, we must note that sharing with the needy is a privilege and not just a duty. As we go out this new week, find someone to put a smile on his or her face, wipe away someone's tears, visit the hospital and pay the medical bill of somebody, reach out to the vulnerable or disadvantaged and become a voice for the oppressed. May the Lord help us as we do these (Amen).
