

**5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 23RD NOVEMBER, 2025**

THEME: CHRIST'S ONCE FOR ALL SACRIFICE

**READING: PSALM PSALM 146; AMOS 5:18-24;
HEBREWS 9:24-28; JOHN 10:7-18.**

The concept of Christ's "Once for All" sacrifice is a fundamental truth in Christianity. It simply means that Jesus Christ, the Son of God came to earth and offered Himself as a sacrifice for our sins, once and for all. His sacrifice on the cross is the ultimate payment for our sins, bringing redemption and reconciliation to all who believe in Him. This sacrifice was not a repeated offering, but a one – time event. In fact, the writer of Hebrews emphasizes that Christ's sacrifice is "once for all" (Hebrews 10:10), meaning it is complete, sufficient and never needs to be repeated.

In the Old Testament, priests would offer sacrifices repeatedly, but Jesus' sacrifice is the final and perfect one (Hebrews 9:26). He took our place, bearing the punishment for our sins, so we wouldn't have to. Therefore, we can boldly state that Christ's sacrifice on the cross is:

- ✓ Complete and Sufficient – It means His sacrifice on the cross is complete and sufficient to cover all our sins. We don't need to add anything to it or repeat it. The sacrifice is enough to save us from sin and its consequences.
- ✓ Perfect Atonement – A closer look at Hebrews 9:28 describes Christ's sacrifice as a perfect atonement. That is, His sacrifice on the cross atones for the sins of human once and for all time.

✓ Display of Love – From Romans 5:8, Christ's sacrifice on the cross demonstrates God's unconditional love for man. His sacrifice paid the price for our redemption, reconciled us to God again and we now have a direct access to the Almighty God through Jesus Christ.

Outlined below are some of the benefits of Christ's sacrifice to believers;

1. By His sacrifice, we receive forgiveness of sins. Thus, our past mistakes, errors and wrongdoings are washed away and we are given a fresh start.
2. According to 2 Cor 5:18-19, Christ's sacrifice on the cross restores our relationship with God, bringing us back into fellowship with the Sovereign God.
3. We receive eternal life through His sacrifice. This simply implies that we would spend eternity with God in heaven.
4. With the help of the Holy Spirit we are able to live a new life in Christ. By His sacrifice we are empowered to live a life that is pleasing to God and beneficial to others. 2 Cor 5:17.
5. Christ's sacrifice gives us access to God's presence. As believers we can now approach God confidently and discuss issues of life bothering us with our father in heaven.

In Conclusion, Christ's once for all sacrifice reminds us of God's immense love and the high price He paid to save us from sin. The sacrifice of Jesus Christ on the cross is the heart of the gospel and it is the source of our hope and salvation. May we cherish this truth, share the good news with others, live in the freedom and joy that comes from knowing that we are loved by God and be motivated to live and serve Him with Joy and passion.
