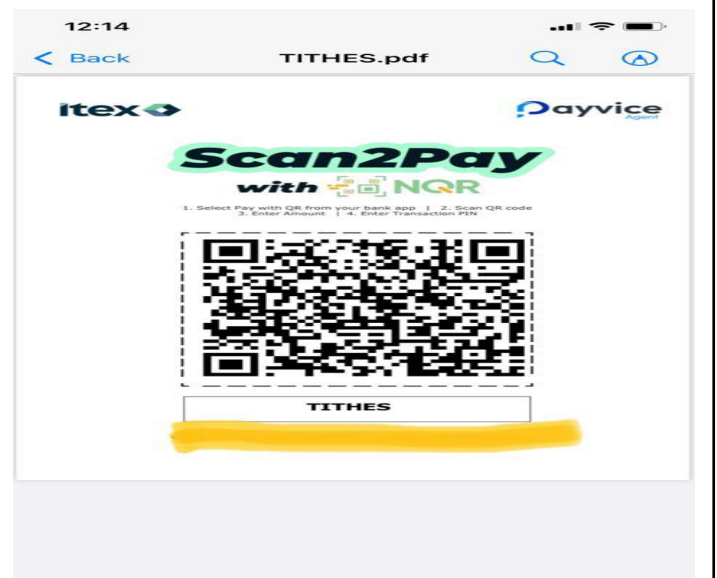

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**  
**SUNDAY, 21<sup>st</sup> DECEMBER, 2025**

THEME: EMBRACING GOD'S WILL FOR YOUR LIFE

READING: PSALM 45:10-END; ISAIAH 7:10-17; ROMANS 1:1-7; LUKE 1:26-38A

As followers of Christ, we're often faced with several decisions in life that will require us to choose between our own plans and God's will. We really want to follow God's path for our lives but sometimes it is very hard to let go of our own plans. Thus, embracing God's will simply means total surrender to His plan for our lives.

It means laying down one's plan, desires, and understanding and saying, "God, let Your will be done on this matter." This is not always easy, especially when God's will take us to places, we don't want to go or requires us to do things we don't want to do. But the good news is that when we surrender to God's plan for our lives, we are acknowledging that He knows the end from beginning and that His ways are higher than ours.

Hence, God's will is not just a suggestion; it's a blueprint for our lives and it's worth seeking.

There are biblical characters who embraced God's will despite challenges, some of them are outlined below:

1. Mary, the mother of Jesus, is a powerful example of someone who embraced God's will for her life. In Luke 1: 26 – 38, God sent angel Gabriel to deliver an important message to Mary. He announced that she would bear a son – Jesus, who would be the Savior of the world. Her response in Luke 1:38 is remarkable: "Behold the maidservant of the Lord! Let it be to me according to your word." She didn't allow her fears or uncertainties get in the way; she simply trusted God and said yes, knowing fully



2. Ruth is also a wonderful example of someone who trusted in God's plan. In Ruth 1, Ruth's husband died, and she could have returned to her own family, but instead, she chose to stay with her mother-in-law, Naomi, and follow God. God blessed Ruth, and she became an ancestor of Jesus Christ, showing us that God has a plan for everyone who trusts in Him.

3. Paul is another great example of someone who dedicated his life to God's will. In Acts 9, Paul was a persecutor of Christians when God appeared to him. After his encounter with God on his way to Damascus, God called him to be a missionary. Paul obeyed and became a vessel unto honour in the hands of God. He went on to spread the gospel message of our Lord Jesus Christ to the Gentiles.

From the above biblical characters, embracing God's will may require our sacrifice, obedience, humility, courage, perseverance and stepping out in faith. As children of God we must carry God along in our everyday lives. We must surrender our daily routines, relationships and priorities to God. When we say yes to God, we shall experience His presence, peace and purpose in our lives.

Beloved people of God, remember that accepting God's will is a lifelong journey, not a one – time decision. There will be ups and downs, twists and turns, but we should keep our eyes fixed on Jesus and trust that He is working everything out for our good. Be assured that God's will is perfect and He is always with you
