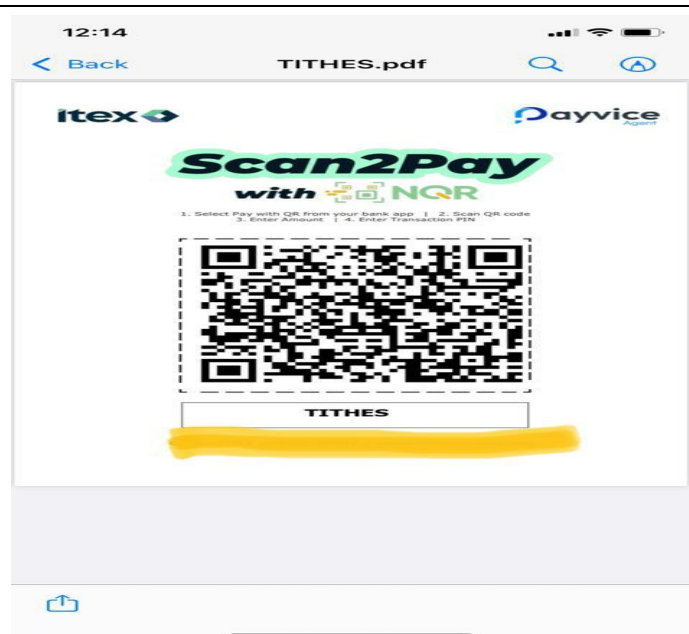

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

SUNDAY, 28th DECEMBER, 2025

THEME: THE WORD BECAME FLESH

**READING: PSALM 2; ISAIAH 62:10-12;
GALATIANS 4:1-7; JOHN 1:14-18**

“The Word became flesh”. This is a phrase most of us, if not all, are familiar with. We read it year in year out, especially during Christmas season. So what does it mean?

The Phrase ‘The Word became Flesh’ is a simple term used in explaining the mystery of Christ's incarnation as both divine and human (God and man). Apostle John describes him in John 1:1 as the ‘Word’ who has been from the beginning, who has also been with God and who is also God.

‘The Word became Flesh’ as believed by many New Testament scholars is the fulfillment of all Old Testament prophecies. Beginning from Genesis 3:15, Jesus said to be coming as the rescuer of all humanity from sin and Satan. Jeremiah 23:5 proclaims that Jesus will be from the tribe of Jesse, a king that deals justly and wisely with all. Finally, we see in Isaiah 7:14 that Jesus is prophesied to be born of a virgin, having God alone as His Father, and being called Immanuel, God with us.

Each of these prophecies is fulfilled as Jesus is conceived by the Virgin Mary (Luke 1:28-38), from the line of Jesse (Matthew 1:5-6), and has ultimately defeated sin, Satan, and death as He bore the weight of the world on the cross and rose from the grave. God becoming flesh means the rescuer we needed in Genesis 3:15 has finally come, and He has come to stay and dwell among us.

The “Word became flesh” is a pivotal phrase from John 1:14 signifying that the divine, pre-existent “Word” (Logos) took on human form as Jesus Christ, embodying God's invisible presence in the visible, tangible world, revealing His glory, grace, and truth to humanity.

It describes the mystery of Jesus’ incarnation, where the eternal God entered human history as a man, becoming both fully divine and fully human to dwell among people, fulfilling prophecy and offering salvation.

According to Galatians 4:4 God sent forth His Son 'The Word' at the fullness of time to redeem those who were under the law and that through Him we may become an heir and no longer slaves. In other words, Jesus (The Word) became flesh and dwelt among us, and made the Father known to us. So, going back to John 1:18 which says "No one has ever seen God, it is the only Son, who is nearest to the Father's heart, who has made him known". Here, John wants us to understand that the reason the Word became flesh was that we might get to know the Father. Jesus is the Father's Word to us. Jesus is the revelation of God the Father. How do we get to know the Father? By getting to know Jesus. Jesus, the Word made flesh, is the way to the Father. If we want to know the Father, go through Jesus.

Six Reasons Why the Word became flesh

1. So that God could dwell with humanity.
2. To reveal God's glory, grace, and truth in a tangible way to humanity.
3. To offer salvation through His life, death, and resurrection.
4. To bridge the gap between the divine and human.
5. To fulfil prophecy.
6. To provide humanity with a path of reconciliation with God.

As Christians, our response to "the Word becoming flesh" should therefore be in awe, worship, and transformation, leading us to make room for Jesus in our hearts, believe in Him as our Saviour, reflect His glory in our lives, and share His grace with the world, becoming His messengers. It is about receiving God's presence, accepting His salvation, and living out His divine life daily as God's children.

"The Word became flesh" is the greatest gift from God to mankind. God loves us and thinks so much about us that He became one of us. Therefore, as we celebrate the birth of Jesus Christ this season, let us not forget that He is the Word that became Flesh. He lived and conquered all sin, all shame, and all death for our sakes. We should therefore use this period to make our hearts and minds focus on the goodness and graciousness of a God who desires all people to know Him and make Him known to those who are yet to know Him so that we can all behold His glory.
