

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 18TH JANUARY, 2026**

THEME: INVITING JESUS CHRIST INTO ALL SITUATION

READING: PSALM 19; 1 SAMUEL 3:1-10;
1 CORINTHIANS 6:11B-20; JOHN 2:1-11.

It is always a delight to be in God's presence! Because only there in can we find Fullness of Joy. The world is filled with uncertainties and doubt, disappointments and heartbreaks, chaos and betrayal. But we find solace in the fact that Jesus have overcomes the world. Glory! What a time in the year to feast on a topic as this. The Bible itself didn't promise a sweet or trier free life but painstakingly reminds us that we would face tribulations but be of good cheer because the cross gave us victory.

In this famous text, The difference between embarrassment and breakthrough at the wedding in Cana was simple: **JESUS WAS INVITED**. How often do we remember Jesus or bring Him into the situations of our life?

However, we must keep to heart that They invited Jesus into the wedding...

But more importantly, they invited Him before the problem came. Mostly, in contemporary times, believers sees their relationship with Jesus as transactional.

This leads us to the first point

1. **HAVE A RELATIONSHIP WITH YOUR REDEEMER:**

In John 2, the wine finished. The celebration was about to become humiliation. But Jesus was already there.

Supposed believers invite Jesus only when things collapse and pray only when they are in trouble, remember God only after human help fails! Yet Scripture says: "In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths." Proverbs 3:6

When Jesus is present from the beginning: shame is prevented, confusion is avoided, crises become testimonies. Do not wait for marriage to break before inviting Jesus or a business to collapse before inviting Jesus. Invite Him into your plans, your decisions, your relationships, your studies your future.

2. **IN THIS NEW YEAR, ALLOW JESUS TO COLONIZE YOU**

Just like we submitted to the British and we were governed according to their traditions and lifestyle, we must also submit to Jesus' instructions for our life.

Mary said "Whatsoever he saith unto you, do it." John 2:5

Many people want Jesus as a guest, not as Lord. Some believers invite Jesus but still want their own will, their own method and their own lifestyle. The miracle happened only when the servants obeyed.

Hence, to invite Jesus is not decoration, it means letting Him correct you, changing habits, submitting your will and obeying His Word even when it doesn't make sense

3. **JESUS IS ABLE TO MAKE ALL GRACE ABOUND: DOING THE EXTRAORDINARY!**

At Cana, Water became wine. The last became the best. The supposed Shame became celebration. When Jesus enters a situation, status quo changes, the norms changes.

He turns weakness into strength, tears into testimony, delay into divine timing, failure into favor "With God nothing shall be impossible." Luke 1:37

What you call ordinary water, Jesus calls future wine. God is able to make all grace abound. there is a grace that makes for lifting, a grace for healing, grace for enlargement, grace for help etc.... That grace is available this year. Yield to Him, let Him lead you aright. Through the word or prayers, be sensitive in your spirit to know when God is passing by you.

CONCLUSION

Beloved in Christ, Miracles begin with an invitation. Breakthrough begins with surrender. Glory begins when Jesus is honored. The wedding at Cana teaches: It is not too late when Jesus is present. It is too early to give up when Jesus has been invited. Don't lose hope because hope doesn't disappoint.
