

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 1ST FEBRUARY, 2026

THEME: JOURNEYING THROUGH LIFE WITH GOD

READING: PSALM 34:11-18; ISAIAH 30:18-21;
1 CORINTHIANS 4:1-13; MATTHEW 5:1-12.

Journeying through life with God is a dynamic relationship where we seek God's presence, follow His lead, surrender our will and plans to His will, rely on His strength and wisdom to navigate life's twists and turns. This journey is not about having a problem free life, but about experiencing God's goodness, love, joy and comfort in the midst of life's mess. Really, the journey can be challenging, but with God on our side, we can navigate through it successfully.

As seen in 1 Cor 4:10-13, Apostle Paul in his letter to the Church at Corinth was simply addressing the pressures and challenges of living for Christ in a world that is often hostile. From the text above, we can clearly see that Paul's focus is on God's approval, not human approval. He's not looking for pats on the back or recognition; he's looking to please God. As believers, it is important to note that following God doesn't exempt us from struggles, but guarantees His presence and strength when we are faced with difficult challenges and tribulations (John 16:33).

Stated below are few biblical figures who persevered through challenges in their walk with God;

1. **Joseph** faced injustice, slavery, and imprisonment, yet he remained faithful and was eventually used by God to save his family and nation (Gen 37 – 50).
2. **David** faced years of running from King Saul, living in caves, and fighting different battles, yet he trusted God and became Israel's greatest king (1 Sam 16-31).
3. **Job** in the midst of unimaginable loss and suffering, remained faithful saying, *"Though He slay me, yet will I trust Him"* (Job 13:15)

As believers, we are also encouraged with the words of our Lord Jesus Christ in Matthew 5: 11-12 which says that, *"Blessed are you when they revile and persecute you, and say all kinds of evil against you falsely for My sake. Rejoice and be exceedingly glad, for great is your reward in heaven, for so they persecuted the prophets who were before you."*

Beloved people of God, let us remember that following God is not a promise of ease, but a promise of His presence. Therefore, as we journey with God, let us fix our eyes on the Sovereign God who is able to guide and lead us to the very end.
