

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 25TH JANUARY, 2026

THEME: THE FAITH THAT WORKS

READING: PSALM 27:1-8; EXODUS 33:12-END; 1 JOHN 1:1-7; MATTHEW 8:1-13.

True faith is not something that stands still but it is a catalyst. It is the crucial connection between a promise of God and the reality of man. Although one may say he or she believes in the power of God, the Christian journey requires one to take the step of inner faith to the outward expression. According to James, the faith without action is dead (James 2:17, 26). Even the demons recognize that God actually exists and shudder, but that intellectual confession is of no redemption (James 2:19). That is why the question is not only Do I believe? but Is my belief working, influencing my decision and addressing my situation?

Matthew 8: 1-13 gives two strong illustrations of this working faith. First, a man who is alone, leper; an outcast under the law. His belief was no silent hope, but an open, loud and naked appeal. Jesus said in direct response to this dynamic trust: I am willing. Be clean." The faith-in-motion of the man became the conduit of healing power of Christ.

Also the Roman centurion, a foreigner. He says, only say the word, and my servant will be healed (Matthew 8:8). This trust in Jesus was so active and intelligent as to astonish Him that He wondered, saying that He had not found such faith in Israel. Jesus next made the decree which the centurion had thought was right: Let it be done even as thou thoughtest (Matthew 8:13). It is the same hour that the servant was cured. Faith was carried out by tactical intercession and unremitting trust in the power of Christ.

Through these portraits we get a scriptural pattern; true faith is belief in physical form. Faith that works is not a belief that is true to nothing; It is the option to make it a part of your character to act according to the character of God in the struggle and to say, This problem is real, but my God is more real.

God reacts to the degree of faith that we utilize (Matthew 9:29). Hebrews 11: 6 is categorical: without faith no one can please God. Acting faith is the faith which gratifies Him. It is the defense of the spiritual assault (Ephesians 6:16).

And we develop working faith with conscious effort:

- Saturate in Scripture: Faith is an upshot of hearing the word of Christ (Romans 10:17). Languish in promises of God.
- Obedience to the word of God
- Practice Sincere Praying: Mark 9:24. Prayer is the exercise of faith.

This week live a lifeoffaith-Heb11:2,6.

- We are to walk by faith and not by sight. 2 Cor.5:7.
 - Your own faith at work could mean Start that your business now
- Let go of that pain and bitterness and forge on.
