5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK SUNDAY, 8TH FEBRUARY, 2026

THEME: GOD'S UNLIMITED POWER TO HEAL

READING: PSALM 77:1-15; II KINGS 5:1-14;
JAMES 5:13-16A; MARK 2:1-12.

Our world is full of stories of pain, ailing bodies, wounded emotions, broken relationships, and weary souls. In such moments, it is easy to wonder, "Can God still heal?" The Bible resounds with a confident answer: Yes, God's power to heal is unlimited.

In Psalm 77, the psalmist begins with deep anguish, crying out in distress. Yet in the midst of his pain, he deliberately remembers "the deeds of the Lord" and the wonders of old. Healing often begins when faith chooses remembrance over despair. When we recall who God has been, we find strength to trust Him for what He can still do. God's healing power is not weakened by time, circumstance, or human limitation.

The story of Naaman in 2 Kings 5 reminds us that God's healing does not always come in the way we expect. Naaman was a powerful man, yet helpless before leprosy. His healing came not through status or strategy, but through humble obedience, washing in the Jordan as instructed. Many miss healing today not because God is unwilling, but because pride resists simple faith. God's power flows freely where humility makes room.

In Mark 2:1-12, we see a deeper dimension of healing. The paralysed man was brought to Jesus by determined friends who refused to be discouraged by obstacles. Before Jesus healed his body, He healed his soul: "Son, your sins are forgiven". This reminds us that God's healing is holistic, He heals the body, the mind, and the spirit.

Sometimes what we call delay is God addressing a deeper need. James 5:13-16 shows that prayer, confession, and mutual care are channels through which God releases His healing power. Healing is not meant to be a private struggle alone; God often works through loving fellowship and faithful intercession.

We still hear testimonies today, of medical reports overturned, of emotional wounds healed through prayer, of families restored after years of brokenness. At the same time, we see people who find peace and strength even when physical healing takes time. In every case, God remains at work, revealing that His power is not limited to instant miracles but includes sustaining grace and inner renewal.

For us this week, let us:

- Bring your pain honestly before God in prayer.
- Obey His Word, even when it feels simple or uncomfortable.
- Allow trusted believers to pray with you.
- Trust that God knows how and when to heal best.

God is still the Great Physician, whose power to heal reaches every wound, seen and unseen. As you trust Him this week, be assured that nothing in your life is beyond His healing touch, and nothing is too hard for the Lord.
