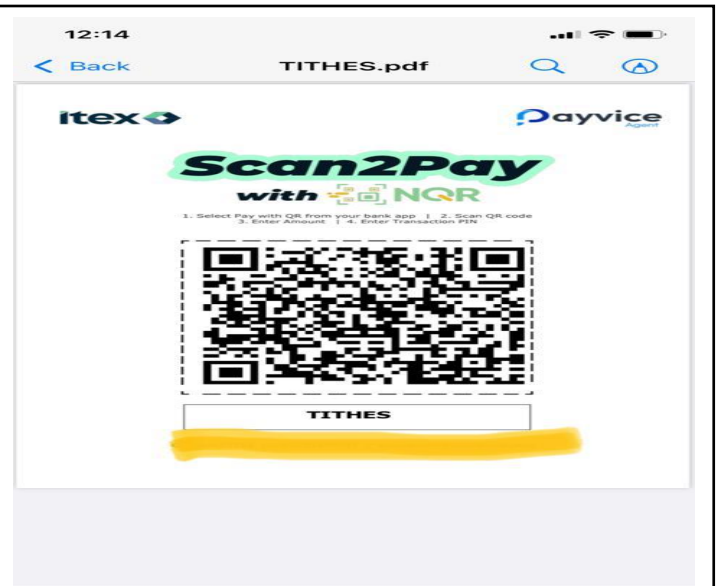

**THEME: THE SIGNIFICANCE OF THE TRIUMPHANT ENTRY**  
**READING: PSALM 24; ZECHARIAH 9:9 – 12; ISAIAH 50:4-9A, PHIL 2:5-11; MATTHEW 21:1-13.**

We bless the name of the Lord for the grace to witness another Palm Sunday as a Church. May His name be forever praised! We look forward to witnessing many more in Jesus' Name. Amen.

The Triumphant Entry of Jesus Christ into Jerusalem is a powerful moment that reveals both His divine identity as the promised Messiah and His mission. Though His entry appears as a celebration, but it is deeper than a parade or applause, for it marks the beginning of the final phase of Christ's earthly ministry, leading to His suffering, death, and ultimate victory through resurrection.

As He entered the city riding on a donkey, He fulfilled the ancient prophecy in Zechariah 9:9 (*Behold, your King is coming to you ..... lowly and riding on a donkey*), presenting Himself as the promised King who brings peace and salvation.

A closer look at today's Gospel (Matthew 21:1-13) shows that, Jesus came as a humble King into Jerusalem. Unlike earthly rulers who come with armies, Jesus came in peace. His entry reminds us that God's kingdom is about humility, love, and service. When Jesus approached the city, the crowds welcomed Him with shouts of "Hosanna!" and spread their cloaks and palm branches on the road.

They recognized Him as the promised Messiah, yet many misunderstood His mission. Some expected a king who would fight for them politically, not a Savior who would bring forgiveness and eternal life. However, Jesus came to fulfill His divine mission by bringing

His entry is not just a story of palm branches and praise alone, it is the announcement of eternal victory that brought redemption to the entire human race. Therefore, we are called to receive Christ not just with outward celebration, but with sincere surrender, allowing Him to reign in our lives, cleanse
