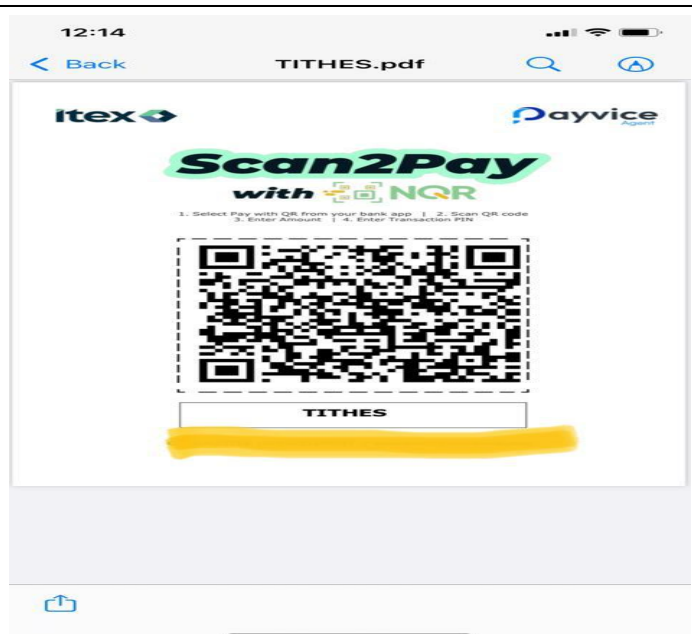

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

SUNDAY, 1ST MARCH, 2026

THEME: SEEKING AND FINDING THE LOST

READING: PSALM 33:17-21; ISAIAH 53:1-12; 1 JOHN 3:1-10; LUKE 15:1-10.

INTRODUCTION

It is with reference that we come before the throne of Grace on these second Sunday in Lent, trusting God that as we humble ourselves and seek His face, turn from our wicked ways, He will hear from Heaven, forgive our sins and heal us as individuals-and by extension heal our land. Amen

As believers, we aren't oblivious of the Great commission that Jesus gave us before ascension. God has epitomized this Himself when He rescued us by giving His son so save us from our sins. The prince of this world on the other hand will do anything to harvest the souls of men. But we have a calling to fulfill, it's Is a call to Go after the lost!

THE GREAT COMMISSION

One of the greatest revelations of God's heart is this: God seeks the lost. Isaiah 53 prophetically shows us how far God would go to rescue the lost and in our epistle in 1 John 3 reveals why He did it, because of His great love to make us His children. We must understand that the cross is not an accident. It is a rescue mission.

I. The Lost Condition of Man (Isaiah 53:6)

“All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way” Sin is not just bad behavior; it is wandering away from God. Like sheep without a shepherd, confused, exposed, and vulnerable. Lost people may look fine outwardly but are separated inwardly.

Being lost means:

Living in self-will (“his own way”)

Living under sin's control (1 John 3:8)

Living without true identity

The tragedy is not that sheep wander. The tragedy is wandering without realizing you are lost! The prodigal son didn't know the extent to which he had wandered

II. The Seeking Savior (Isaiah 53:4–5, 11–12)

Isaiah 53 shows us a suffering Servant:

“He was wounded for our transgressions, He was bruised for our iniquities, The Lord laid on Him the iniquity of us all.”

Jesus did not wait for the lost to find Him. He came searching. He Bore our griefs, Carried our sorrows, Took our punishment, Paid our debt. This is divine pursuit. On the cross, Jesus was treated as lost, So that the lost could be found.

III. The Price of Finding the Lost

Seeking is costly! Isaiah 53 shows: Rejection “Who hath believed our report?, Suffering, Silence before accusers, Death among transgressors.

Love always pays a price. The Shepherd did not send a servant. He became the sacrifice. How ready are we to pay the price in our work space, schools, families and even in the church do that the souls of men will be restored back to God?

IV. The Result: Becoming Children of God (1 John 3:1)

“Behold, what manner of love the Father hath bestowed upon us, that we should be called the sons of God.”

The lost are not just forgiven. They are adopted. What a father we have in God. The Bible explains in John 1 that to many that believes, them He gave the power to become sons of God.

From:

- Wanderers → Children
- Rebels → Sons
- Sinners → Righteous in Christ

1 John 3 says:

Those who are born of God do not continue in sin. A found sheep does not keep running back to wolves. Finding produces transformation.

5. The Evidence of Being Found (1 John 3:6–10)

How do we know someone has been found? They do not live in habitual sin. They practice righteousness. They reflect their new Father. You resemble who you belong to.

The devil produces sin. God produces righteousness. Seeking leads to finding. Finding leads to becoming.

6. Our Responsibility: Join the Search

If we are children of God, we must reflect the Father’s heart.

God seeks the lost.

So must we.

- In our families
- In our churches
- In Lagos, in Nigeria, everywhere

There are many who sit in church but are still lost. Have religion but no relationship. Know scriptures but not the Savior. We must seek with compassion, not condemnation.

Conclusion

Isaiah 53 shows the suffering and shows the transformation in the epistle read to us. The call of God is laborers. Believers who are ready to not be satisfied with being called but being sent. Jesus was rejected so we could be received. He was wounded so we could be healed. He was treated like a sinner so we could be called sons.
