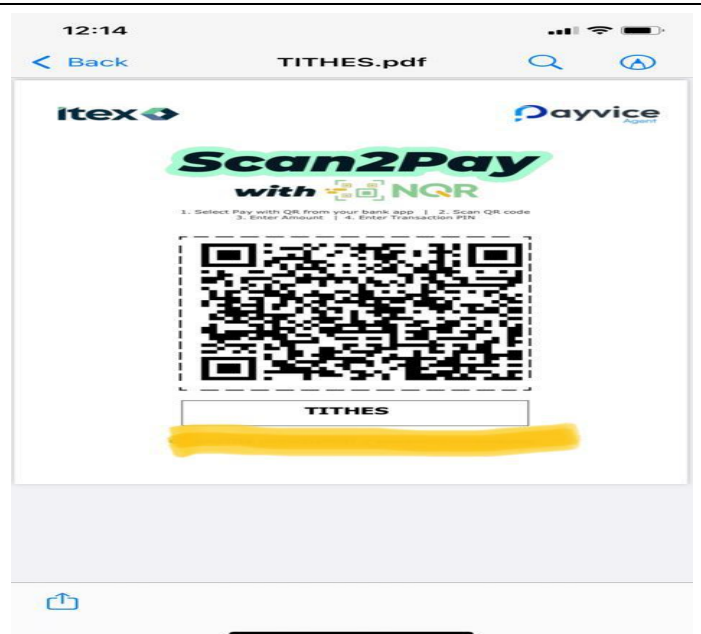

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

SUNDAY, 22ND FEBRUARY, 2026

THEME: OVERCOMING TEMPTATION

READING: PSALM 119:1-8; GENESIS 2:7-9; JAMES 1:2-19; MATTHEW 4:1-11.

In the Gospel reading for today, we read about how Jesus (our role model, perfect example and High Priest- Hebrews 4:15) was tempted by the tempter (the devil) three times, but he was able to overcome the three temptations by standing on the word of God (Matthew 4:1-11). Not only that, He was also tempted by God's chosen people (1st Corinthians 10:9), the Jewish leaders (Matthew 16:1), His disciples (Matthew 16:23) and many others throughout His earthly ministry (Luke 22:28, Hebrews 2:18).

Temptation is different from sin and temptation on its own is not sin, but temptation can lead to sin and can become sin when yielded to (James 1:15). In fact the Bible does not go against us from being faced with trials and temptation (John 16:33), rather it encourages us to know that temptations and trials are tests of our faith which produces patient (James 1:2&3). It also confirms that whoever overcomes temptation becomes blessed and will receive a crown of life that God promises to those who love Him (James 1:12).

As believers we all face different temptations per day. What the devil does is to find our weakest points and seduce us with them. Whether it be sexual temptation, anger, jealousy, covetousness, laziness, pride, insecurity, worry, or any others form of temptation. It is very important to understand that the way we handle temptations affects our walk with Jesus, our spiritual health and growth.

Apart from the temptation that the tempter brings or imposes on us by other external forces. Most of the time temptation comes from within, when a person is lured and enticed by his own desire. It could be personal and internal (Lust of the Flesh, Lust of the Eyes, Pride of Life - 1st John 2:16).

Usually, when we are tempted, a thought first comes to mind. The more we think about the temptation the more power it has on us. Knowing that our thoughts are the first seed of every temptation (James 1:14&15), we must therefore replace those thoughts with God's Word. Instead of thinking about the temptation, we should set our minds on God's Word (Psalm 119:9, 11).

How to overcome temptation

Psalm 119:1-5 which formed part of our reading today and some other verses of the Bible gives us some simple guide on how we can overcome temptation;

1. Walk in the Law of God (Psalm 119:1)
2. Keep the testimonies of God (Psalm 119:2a)
3. Seek God with your whole heart (Psalm 119:2b)
4. Walk in the ways of God (Psalm 119:3)
5. Keep God's precepts diligently (Psalm 119:4)
6. Keep the statutes of God and do not forsake them (Psalm 119:5b)
7. By studying and meditating on the word of God (Ephesians 4:26-32)
8. Prayer (Matthew 6:13, Thessalonians 5:17)
9. By the words of testimony (Revelation 12:11)
10. Put your interest on spiritual things (Colossians 3:2)
11. Be busy for God
12. Flee from sinful appearances
13. Avoid whatever the devil always use to tempt you.
14. Determine not to fall into temptation
15. Seek spiritual counsel.

Examples of people who overcame temptation in the Bible

1. Joseph was able to overcome the temptation of sexual immorality by refusing to sleep with Potiphar's wife (Genesis 39:7-9).
2. Daniel was able to overcome the temptation of defiling his body by refusing to eat from the portion of the king's meat (Daniel 1:8).
3. Job, despite losing his wealth, health, and children, Job refused to curse God, overcoming the temptation to abandon his faith under extreme suffering (Job 13:15).
4. Jesus was able to overcome the temptation of the devil by refusing to bow to the devil by using the word of God (Matthew 4:1-11).
5. Apostle Paul, Overcame temptations associated with suffering, including persecution, danger, and hardship.

Temptation is something we will continue to experience as long as we live. The fact that we were able to overcome a temptation does not mean it is over. In Luke 4:13, it was stated that the devil after been rebuked by Jesus went for a while (a season). Which means he is most likely to come back. However, when he comes to try us, be rest assured that God is able to make a way of escape for you to overcome (1st Corinthians 10:13).

As we fast this Lenten season, we must bear in mind that the devil (the tempter) will try us with different temptations just as he did to Jesus after He had fasted forty days and forty nights. But when temptation comes let us not forget to put our trust in God to help us overcome through Jesus Christ and that He is able to keep us from stumbling and to present us faultless before the presence of His glory with exceeding joy (Jude 24&25).
