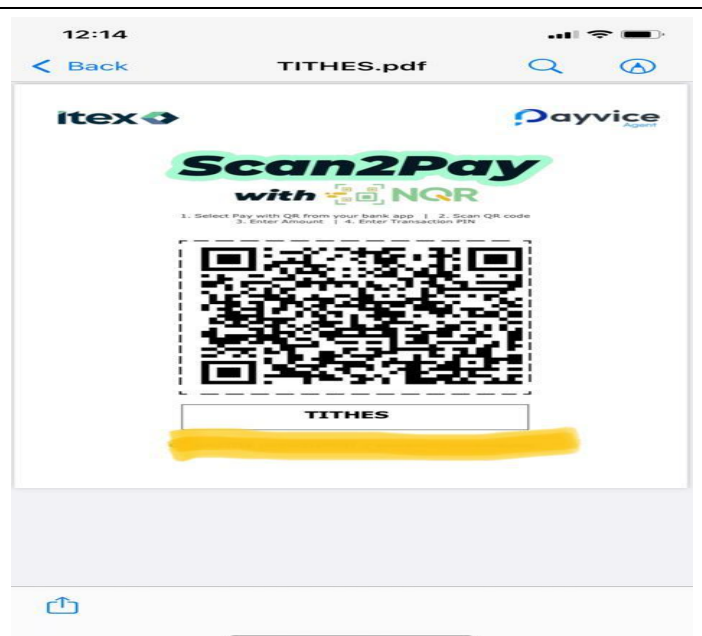

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**
SUNDAY, 10TH MAY, 2026

THEME: FOCUSING ON ETERNITY

**READING: PSALM 68:14-20; EZEKIEL 38:8-13;
COLOSSIANS 3:1-11; JOHN 16:23-33.**

You are welcome to church in the name of our Lord and Saviour Jesus Christ. We thank God, we made it into the month of May. The grace of God that brought us into the month of May will lead us through the year unhurt and safe in Jesus' name.

Today is Rogation Sunday and it's such a significant day in the Church where we seek God's blessing on the works of our hand, our community, and the well-being. The word rogation comes from the Latin verb *rogare*, meaning "to ask", which reflects the beseeching of God for protection from calamities. As the Book of Common Prayer puts it: "Rogation Days are the three days preceding Ascension Day, especially devoted to asking for God's blessing on agriculture and industry." Therefore, the summary of Rogation Sunday is asking God to open His heaven and rain His blessing upon all that we do.

Today's topic is Focusing on Eternity because only those who live in the power of the resurrection can enjoy endless flow of God's blessing. Focusing of eternity is not merely a theological concept but a transformative reality that shapes the core of one's existence. This is a life encounter with the resurrected Lord that has changed one's experience about the efficacy of the power of God resurrect and restore. The resurrection of Jesus Christ symbolizing victory over sin, death, and the grave. Its power reverberates through every aspect of a believer's life, offering hope, purpose, and eternal life.

Undeniably, focusing on eternity is embracing the profound truth that death does not have the final say because the seed of Christ's victory has been planted in us already. Just as Christ conquered death and rose again, believers are invited into a new way of being – one marked by freedom from fear and the assurance of eternal life. This assurance permeates through the highs and lows of life, infusing each moment with a sense of divine purpose and destiny.

Focusing on Eternity in various dimensions of life.

1. It transforms one's perspective on suffering and adversity. In the face of trials, the resurrection reminds believers that pain is not the end of the story. Just as Christ emerged from the tomb triumphant, so too can individuals find strength and resilience amid their struggles, knowing that God's power is made perfect in weakness.
2. It instills a deep sense of identity and belonging. Through Christ's victory, believers are not only reconciled to God but also to one another, forming a diverse yet unified community known as the body of Christ. This fellowship transcends barriers of race, culture, and nationality, reflecting the inclusive love of the resurrected Savior.
3. It empowers believers to live with boldness and purpose. Freed from the shackles of sin and guilt, individuals are called to embrace their God-given gifts and talents, contributing to the advancement of God's kingdom on earth. Whether in vocation, relationships, or service to others.

4. It serves as a source of hope and anticipation for the future. Just as Christ was raised to new life, believers look forward to the promise of resurrection and eternal fellowship with God. This hope transcends the temporal challenges of the present age, anchoring believers in the assurance of God's faithfulness and the ultimate triumph of His kingdom.

FOCUSING ON ETERNITY INCLUDES:

1. **Seek And Set Your Heart on Eternal Values (Col. 3:1-2):** Setting our sights on heaven means striving to put heaven's priorities into daily practice. Letting heaven fill our thoughts and concentrating on the eternal rather than the temporal (Philippians 4:7, Colossians 3:15). Our heart is the center of conflict because that is where our feelings and desires clash. So, in the midst of thick and thin of this world, we must allow Christ's peace and righteousness rule heart and actions. As God's children, we to live in ongoing repentance from sin, to make the Kingdom of God our primary concern, to put God first in our life, to fill our thoughts with his desires, to take his character for our pattern, and to serve and obey him in everything.
2. **Dead to sin and living for God (Col. 3:3-9):** One of the features of living things is ability to respond to stimulus. A response is the behavior that is manifested by a living organism which is the result of an external or internal stimulus. A stimulus is anything that causes you to react, for example, to the smell of food and your mouth watering etc. so, a dead person does not respond to stimulus again. He is dead. He has been transited from one world to another celestial realm. So, it is for us, we do not respond to the culture and standard of this sinful world again. We have been moved! What it means is that our life is hidden with Christ. Christ gives us power to live for him now. We should consider ourselves dead and unresponsive to sexual immorality, impurity, lust, shameful desires, and greed. Just like diseased limbs of a tree, these practices must be cut off before they destroy us. We must make a conscious, daily decision to remove anything that supports or feeds these desires and to rely on the Holy Spirit's power.
3. **Put on the New Nature (Col. 3:10):** What does it mean to clothe ourselves with a brand-new nature? It means that our conduct should match our faith. If we are Christian, we should act like it. To be a Christian means more than just making good resolutions and having good intentions; it means taking the right actions. This is a straightforward step that is as simple as putting on our clothes. Every Christian is in a continuing education program. The more we know of Christ and his work, the more we are being changed to be like him. Because this process is lifelong, we must never stop learning and obeying.

In conclusion, living in the power of resurrection is a transformative journey that every Christian must desire. This is a kind of life bought for us through the death and resurrection of Jesus Christ. This life shapes our perspective, identity, purpose, and hope. It is a call to embrace the fullness of life made possible through Christ's victory over death, allowing His resurrection power to pass through every aspect of our existence. As we walk in the reality of the risen Christ, we embody the power of God's love for the world.
