5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**
SUNDAY, 24TH MAY, 2026

THEME: GOD'S PROMISED SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS

READING: PSALM 130; JOEL 2:28-32; ACTS 2:1-21; JOHN 20:19-31.

INTRODUCTION

Have you ever received a promise that seemed too good to be true? We live in a world where promises are often broken, but God's promises never fail. When the Holy Spirit came down on the day of Pentecost in Acts 2, it was not by accident. It was God keeping His word. Tongues of fire rested on the disciples, and they were filled with power from above. Earlier, in John 20, the risen Jesus breathed on His followers and gave them His peace. These two events show us something amazing: God has given every believer real spiritual blessings. These blessings are not just for the future. They are for right now. They are gifts already given to us, sealed by the Holy Spirit, and ready to be enjoyed. From being made right with God to having eternal life, these seven blessings change everything about who we are and what we have in Christ.

GOD'S PROMISED SPIRITUAL BLESSINGS

1. **Made Right and Set Apart for God**

This is the first and most basic blessing we receive. Through what Jesus did for us, we get a completely fresh start:

- **Made Right:** All our sins are forgiven. God no longer holds anything against us. It is as if we never sinned.
- **Set Apart:** We are now holy, set apart for God's special purposes. We belong to Him.
- **Help to Live Right:** The Holy Spirit gives us the power to live a life that pleases God. We do not have to do it by our own strength.

2. **Brought into God's Family**

Sin once separated us from God, but that separation is now gone. We are no longer outsiders. We are His dear children:

- **A New Name:** We are legally adopted into God's family. We can now call Him "Abba," which means Father.
- **The Spirit of Adoption:** The Holy Spirit in our hearts confirms that we truly are God's children. He takes away our fear and gives us a deep sense of belonging.
- **Heirs with Jesus:** Because we are children, we share in the same inheritance that belongs to Jesus.

3. **A Lasting Inheritance**

Being in God's family means we have an inheritance that can never be taken away. This is a two-way gift:

- **We Inherit God:** God Himself becomes our greatest treasure and reward.
- **God Inherits Us:** We become His own special people. He lives in us through the Holy Spirit.
- **Kept Safe in Heaven:** This inheritance will never spoil, fade, or lose its value. It is reserved in heaven just for us, and the Holy Spirit is our guarantee that we will receive it.

4. Direct Access to God

The wall of sin between us and God has been torn down forever:

- Boldness to Come Near: Like the disciples gathered in the upper room, we can now come straight into God's presence. We do not need any other person to stand between us and God.
- Help in Time of Need: We can approach God's throne of grace with confidence. There we find mercy and help exactly when we need it.
- Close Friendship: The Holy Spirit makes this close connection possible. Prayer becomes a real conversation with a loving Father.

5. Marked with the Holy Spirit

The blessing of Pentecost means the Holy Spirit lives in us permanently. He is God's seal on our lives:

- A Seal of Ownership: Long ago, a king's seal made a document official and unchangeable. The Holy Spirit is God's seal on us, marking us as His own.
- A Guarantee: The Spirit is like a down payment. He is God's unbreakable promise that we will receive our full inheritance one day.
- Total Security: This seal cannot be removed. It gives us complete confidence until the day we are fully redeemed.

6. Peace of Mind

In a world full of trouble, Jesus gives us a peace that the world cannot offer:

- A Deep Calm: This is a peace that goes beyond what we can understand. It is a quiet confidence that God is in control.
- Hearts at Rest: Jesus told His disciples not to let their hearts be troubled. This peace comes from trusting Him, not from having perfect circumstances.
- Fruit of the Spirit: This lasting calm is produced in us by the Holy Spirit. It remains steady even when life is stormy.

7. Eternal Life

The greatest blessing of all is the gift of life that never ends, starting right now:

- More Than Living Forever: Eternal life is not just about length of days. It is a new quality of life—knowing God and Jesus personally.
- A Present Gift: This life does not begin when we die. It begins the moment we believe. The very life of God is at work in us today through the Spirit.
- The Promise Fulfilled: As Peter declared on the day of Pentecost, everyone who calls on the name of the Lord will be saved. This is the promise of forever-life that defeats death itself.

CONCLUSION

These blessings are not just nice ideas to think about. They are your real spiritual inheritance, paid for by Jesus on the cross and delivered to you at Pentecost. When Jesus breathed on His disciples and said, "Receive the Holy Spirit," He was opening a treasure chest of grace for everyone who would believe in Him. You stand forgiven, adopted, and sealed—not because you earned it, but because God promised it. You have open access to His throne, a peace that goes beyond understanding, and an inheritance that will never fade. In a world that constantly tries to label you and pull you down, hold on to this truth: you are a child of God, marked by His Spirit, and destined for eternal life. So live boldly in these blessings. They are not something you need to chase after. They are something you already have. The same Holy Spirit who came at Pentecost lives in you right now as your helper, your guarantee, and your greatest gift.
