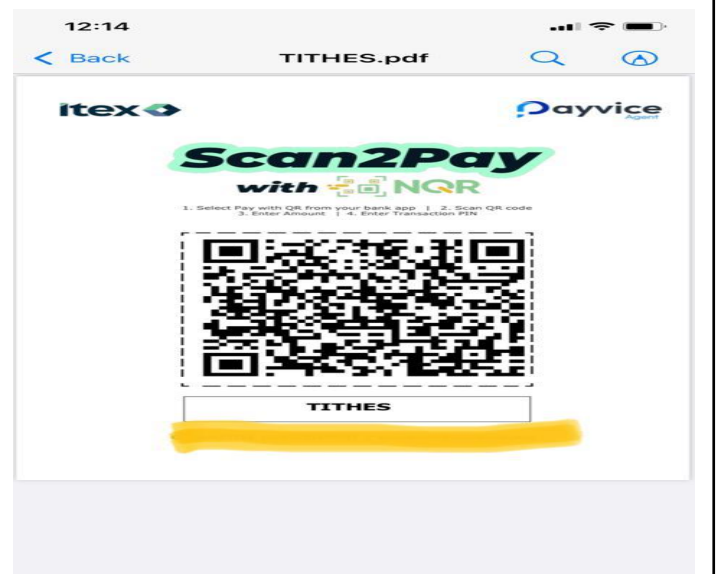

5. THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK

SUNDAY, 14TH JUNE, 2026

THEME: ENDING THE REIGN OF SIN IN OUR DAILY LIVING

READING: PSALM 71:16-24; DEUTERONOMY 6:17-25; ROMANS 6:3-11; JOHN 15:5-11;

Sin, in biblical terms, is any action, thought, or attitude that falls short of God's perfect standard of holiness. It is a rebellion against God's authority and a deviation from His will. The reign of sin is characterized by its pervasive influence over human behavior and its ability to enslave individuals, leading them away from righteousness.

Frankly, there are certain sins which more easily entangle each of us than other ones (Hebrews 12:1). This may be as a result of our past life cultivated habits of sin (addictions) which now plague us even after our salvation or as a result of our spiritual weakness even after becoming Christians. Example of such personal habitual sins includes, lying, gossiping, stealing, drunkenness, idolatry, adultery, fornication, e.t.c. Paul in his epistle to the Galatians calls it 'works of the flesh' (Galatians 5:19-21). They are the sins which we commit and then confess and then commit again and then confess and then commit again and then confess and go on that way in our lives. Through this life style, many of us have given chance to the reign of sin in our daily living and endeavours. It is a pity that today an average believer cannot go a day without lying, gossiping, keeping malice, hating others, getting drunk, getting involved in idolatry, or committing adultery and fornication e.t.c. This attitude shows a life style of the reign of sin which today's topic aims at helping us to understand how we can put an end to in our daily living.

Ending the reign of sin refers to breaking the spiritual dominion and mastery of sin over a person's life. In the epistle of Paul to the Romans, he encourages believers to be dead to sin, *"Likewise you also, reckon yourselves to be dead indeed to sin, but alive to God in Jesus Christ our Lord (Roman 6:11)*. Ending the reign of sin ***will never be easy, but it is possible. It begins with repentance, been dead to sin and*** shifting our identity from being under the law of sin to living under grace (obedience to the law of God). Ending the reign of sin is a daily, lifelong battle that can be won not by self-effort, but by union with Christ. Because as Christians, we have been justified through Jesus and are
