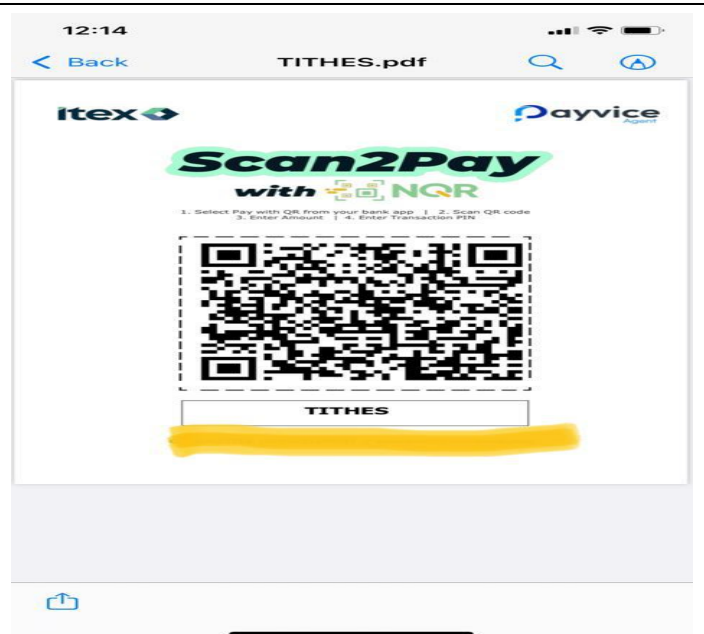

SUNDAY, 12TH JULY, 2026

THEME: **LOVING AS GOD DIRECTS**

READING: **PSALM 119:33-48; HOSEA 11:1-9;
1 JOHN 2:8-17; MARK 12:28-34.**

We warmly welcome you to your father's house this beautiful Sunday morning! It is our prayer that as we gather to commune and fellowship with one another, the Lord will meet us at the point of our needs, and we shall not return home empty – handed in Jesus' Name. Amen.

In the Gospel reading for today, our Lord Jesus Christ teaches that the greatest commandment is to love God with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength, and to love our neighbor as ourselves (Mark 12: 30-31). This divine instruction reveals that genuine love is not merely an emotion but a wholehearted commitment to honor God and reflect His character in our relationships with our neighbors. Therefore, to love as God directs means to love according to His will and His Word. It is a love that is selfless, forgiving, compassionate, patient, sacrificial, and seeking for the good of others. A closer study of Mark 12:30-31 gives us a clearer understanding of today's theme, **"Loving as God Directs."** Let us carefully reflect on these verses and apply their lasting biblical principles to our daily lives.

**LOVING GOD WHOLEHEARTEDLY
(Mark 12:30)**

To love God wholeheartedly is to make Him the highest priority in every area of our lives. Jesus commands us to love the Lord with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength, indicating a complete and undivided devotion to Him. Such love is expressed through sincere worship, wholehearted obedience to His Word, steadfast faith, and a daily commitment to live for His glory. When God occupies the first place in our hearts, every aspect of our lives reflects our love and reverence for Him.

LOVING OUR NEIGHBOUR AS OURSELVES (Mark 12:31)

Flowing from our love for God is the command to love our neighbors as ourselves. Christ teaches that genuine love is demonstrated through kindness, compassion, forgiveness, generosity, and practical care for others without discrimination. Loving our neighbor means seeking their welfare, treating them with dignity and respect, and being willing to serve them in both words and deeds. As believers, we glorify God when His love is evident in our relationships with family, friends, colleagues, and even strangers.

LOVING EVEN OUR ENEMIES (Mathew 5:43-44)

However, it is important to note that one of the greatest marks of Christian maturity is the willingness to love even those who oppose, offend, or persecute us. Jesus calls His followers to rise above hatred and retaliation by praying for their enemies, doing good to those who mistreat them, and responding to evil with grace and forgiveness. Such sacrificial love reflects the character of our Heavenly Father, who shows mercy to both the righteous and the unrighteous. By loving our enemies, we become living witnesses of Christ's transforming love and demonstrate the perfection of God's love in a broken world.

Dearly beloved, as we reflect on today's theme, let us continually seek the grace to love the Lord with all our heart, soul, mind, and strength, and to love our neighbors as ourselves. May the Holy Spirit enable us to walk daily in this holy calling, so that our lives may glorify God and bear faithful witness to Christ our Lord. Amen

ACTION POINT: As you go this week, intentionally reach out to someone you have not spoken to or checked on for a while. Show God's love through a kind call, a visit, a WhatsApp message, or an act of kindness, and let your life reflect the love of Christ in practical ways.
