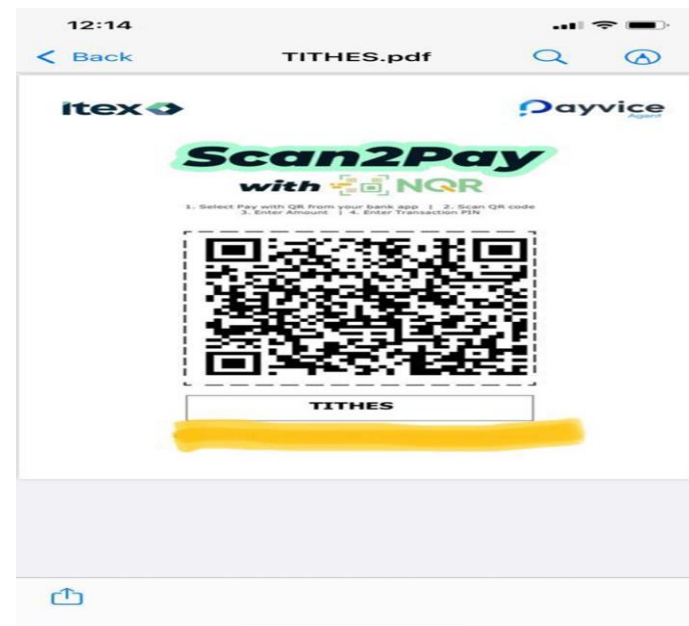

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

SUNDAY, 2nd AUGUST, 2026

**THEME: BEING A SHEPHERD AND NOT A
HIRELING**

**READING: PSALM 119:81-96; PROVERBS 7:7-10
1 PETER 5:1-11; MATTHEW 18:1-16.**

In the Old Testament, the “shepherd” metaphor is usually applied to spiritual leaders while the term “hireling” is used to describe individuals who work for wages rather than out of loyalty.

In the New Testament, Jesus in John 10:11-14, gave a primary difference between a shepherd and a hireling which is their motivation for tending the sheep. The hireling does it for his own benefit and the shepherd does it for the benefit of the sheep. The shepherd stands in when things get tough and does all what he can to protect and care for the sheep. In contrast, when tending the sheep no longer benefits the hireling, he is nowhere to be found and leaves the sheep scattered and unprotected.

Unfortunately, one of the major challenge the church is having today is the challenge of hireling leadership rather than shepherd leadership. The church today is not without those who feel no obligation to defend the truth against false teachers and godless philosophies. This was also what Peter noticed in his first general epistle as he encouraged the early believers and reassuring them of their calling in Christ. So in 1st Peter 5:2, he called for the elders of the church to be shepherds of the flock not by compulsion but willingly not for dishonest gain as a hireling does. In other words they should become shepherd rather than a hireling.

As believers, this is our calling as servants of the new covenant, we are to care for God’s flock like a shepherd and not a hireling.

In [Ezekiel 34:3-6](#), the Lord rebukes the shepherds of Israel. He rebuked them for eating the fat of the sheep and clothing themselves with their wool. They had not strengthened the sickly, nor healed the diseased, nor bound up. They had not gone out to bring back the scattered sheep, nor protected the sheep from wild animals. Instead they had ruled the sheep with force and severity. They were hirelings and not true shepherds.

They seek their own and work for pay. In contrast, we see in verses 11-16 how a true shepherd behaves. He cares for his sheep, feeds them, leads them to rest, seeks the lost sheep, brings back the backslidden ones, and strengthens the sick ones. A good shepherd even lays down his life for the sheep.

Attributes of a good shepherd

1. They will not despise the flock. Matthew 18:10
2. They always go in search of the lost sheep. Matthew 18:12
3. They rejoice when they find a wandered sheep. Matthew 18:13
4. They give gentle leadership to the flock. John 10:5
5. They show sacrificial love to the flock. John 10:11
6. They make provision and seek rest for the flock. Psalm 23:1&2
7. They give protection and guidance to the flock. Psalm 23:4

Attributes of a hireling.

1. Motivated by Money
2. Lacks compassion for the flock
3. Lacks genuine ownership over the flock
4. Flees from danger
5. Self-interested
6. Superficial care

Dearly beloved in Christ, in whatever position we occupy, we have been called by God to be good shepherds over His flock. The sheep is vulnerable to any form of predator, it is therefore the foremost responsibility of the shepherd to protect it. A shepherd's role is two-fold: feeding and tending the sheep (John 21:15-17).

The shepherd tends the sheep by looking after, watching over and caring for the sheep, to minister and wait on the sheep. The shepherd feeds the sheep with the word of God (Jeremiah 3:15, Jeremiah 15:16, 1 Peter 2:2, Hebrews 5:12-14), and trains them in the way they should go so that when they grow they will not depart from it (Proverbs 22:6). He knows them individually and they are known by him.

While the shepherd is seen as a leader who cares for, guides, protects, and nurtures those entrusted to him. A hireling is anyone who refuses to confront sin with sincere and strong rebuke and unwilling to stand squarely on biblical principles in dealing with church matters.

If I may ask, who are you? Are you a shepherd or a hireling?
