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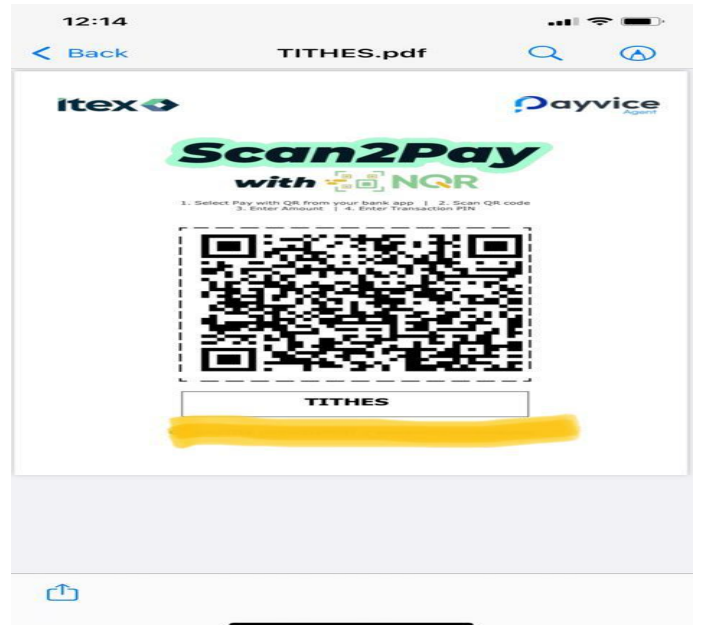

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK**

SUNDAY, 5TH JULY, 2026

THEME: GOD DEMANDS TOTAL OBEDIENCE

READING: PSALM 119:17-32; GENESIS 12:1-9;

ROMANS 12:1-8; LUKE 15:11-32.

Introduction

Today, Christianity has taken a dangerous step: it has made it believe that it is okay to do some things right and some things wrong in God's eyes. Scripture, however, repeatedly testifies to the contrary.

The message is clear from Paul's call to be "wholehearted" in Romans 12, through to Jesus' parable in Luke 15, that nothing can replace wholehearted obedience and that it is demanded by God.

Romans 12:1-2 The Call to Surrender

Paul starts where he's got an appeal that really comes out strong: "Present your bodies a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service. Notice that he says it is reasonable. Total surrender is not extreme in view of God's Mercy, it is required.

Then he tells us don't be conformed to this world but be transformed in the renewing of our minds. Total obedience starts from within. God's Word renews a man's mind, which results in lives living in line with God's plan. Otherwise it's compromise.

The life of the mind is no longer your own, but is dedicated to serving Him.

True obedience involves also the use of all that God has given. Paul gives a list of gifts each with a divine expectation. Disobeying your gift is to ignore it. It is rebellion to use it for personal gain. God requires that all gifts be used in a humble, diligent, and purposeful manner for His kingdom.

The Cost of Disobedience (Luke 15:11-24)

The prodigal son is the illustration of each person who prefers self-will to submission. He forfeited his inheritance, defied his father and squandered it all. His disobedience did not just cost him money, it cost him his dignity, identity and purpose.

However, when he "came to himself" and got up to go back, the father ran out to meet him. Repentance and return are acts of obedience — and are the source of restoration. On the other side of surrender was the robe, the ring, the feast and the sandals.

Hollow obedience Luke 15:25-32

The older son is no less convincing. So he never left home, but his heart was not at home. He served out of duty and entitlement, but not love. He was outwardly dutiful, and yet inwardly disobedient. God has no need for religious show. He is looking for the true surrender of the heart, sons and daughters of the Lord who serve because they are grateful, not because they have been commanded.

Conclusion

Obedience is a commitment and practice of the day. Romans 12 challenges us to present our bodies, our minds, and our gifts, totally to God. Luke 15 reminds us of the destruction that may come as a result of self-will, and the beauty that awaits those who return to the Father.

God is not asking you to obey so that He can reduce your life — He's asking you to obey so He can add to your life. The most fulfilled, the most purposeful and powerful life a human being can have is a life given over to God. The Father is standing in the distance, watching and waiting to run. Only one question is left — will you get up and come home?
