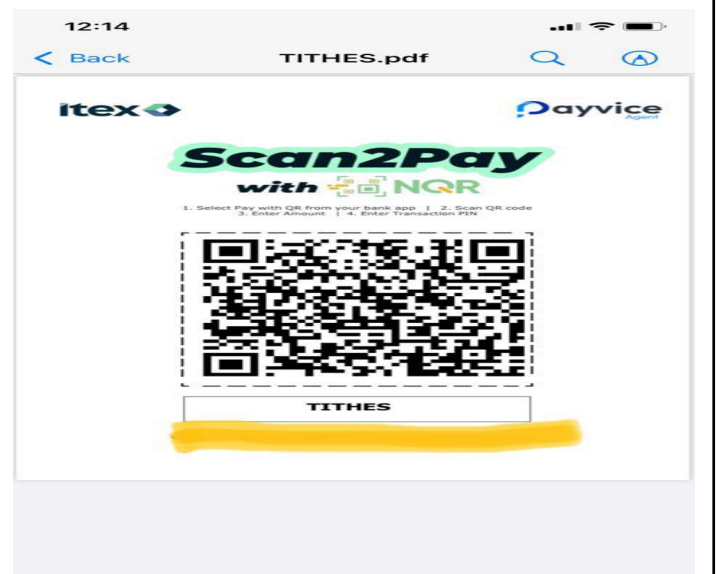

SUNDAY, 9TH AUGUST, 2026

THEME: PRACTICISING CHRISTIAN BENEVOLENCE

**READING: PSALM 119:97-112; 1 CHRO. 29:1-9
ACTS 2:41-47; MATTHEW 25:31-46.**

Introduction

Matthew 25: 31-46 is a passage where Jesus gives a description of the final judgment in which the Son of Man separates the nations as a shepherd separates his sheep from his goats. The division isn't based on religious knowledge or attendance, but on the little things; giving food to the hungry; welcoming strangers; clothing the naked; visiting the sick and imprisoned. Jesus says that true faith isn't a belief I say I have, but what I do for others.

Our faith is validated by the act of Benevolence.

- The work of Benevolence reveals the authenticity of our faith.

The upright are surprised when the Lord says, "Truly, truly, I say to you, whenever you did this for one of the least of my brethren, you did it for me. (v. 37)—and they weren't doing what they did to get to heaven. Their kindness was not done for religious reasons but came from their transformed hearts. We are saved by grace, and have been made for good works, which is the very same thing that's addressed in Ephesians 2:8-10.

James 2:17: "faith without works is dead." Faith must be active. The real virtue of benevolence is not an extraordinary sacrifice but the spontaneous overflow of a heart formed by Christ.

2. **Benevolence is a matter of spiritual seeing; seeing**

Christ in others.

The greatest comment in this passage is the last, verse 40, "what you did for one of the least of these brothers and sisters you did for me. Jesus identifies with the poor and the suffering, and it becomes His way of serving the poor and the suffering. The goats are not judged unkind but unkind towards the weak, incapable of seeing divine dignity in the weak.

Each child who hungers, each widow who is alone, each imprisoned soul, each stranger who seeks a place of rest bears the image of God. We need to have eyes to see beyond poverty, status, circumstance to see a soul precious to God.

3. **Benevolence Demands Action, Not Mere Sentiment**

Note: The goats aren't "evil" per se, they are simply not doing anything. Their sin was to not give me something to eat: "I was hungry and you gave me nothing" (v. 42), says Jesus. Being righteous, and feeling good about oneself because one has not done explicitly bad things, is easy, but Jesus plays a major game of neglecting opportunities to love and it is a serious game.

1 John 3:17-18 reiterates this: "But if anyone has what is needed and sees a brother or sister in need and shows no



5. The Power of Benevolence has Lasting Effects

This passage doesn't conclude with gentle suggestions, it ends with eternal separation: "eternal punishment" for the goats, "eternal life" for the sheep (v. 46). This is one of the most unequivocal and obvious parallels between our attitudes to others and our final destiny in heaven as found in the Bible. This does not impugn the doctrine of salvation by grace, but it does demonstrate that true faith always bears fruits of love and compassion. When we do nothing about the pain in others, we need to ask ourselves what kind of faith we have.

For the week ahead, Brethren, ask yourself,

Who's hungry round here? a poor neighbor or a family who is quietly without food.

Who is the one who's an outsider and needs a welcome? visitors, an outsider,

Who is the one who is ill, and left behind? Procession of the elderly was seldom undertaken, and the sick were often not visited.

Who is in prison (Spiritual or Physical)? The prisoners or ensnared by addiction and despair
Christian benevolence is not for the missionary or the rich; it must be the normal duty of every Christian, manifested in those common acts with which we live our daily lives, a common meal, a listening ear, a visit made, a stranger welcomed.
