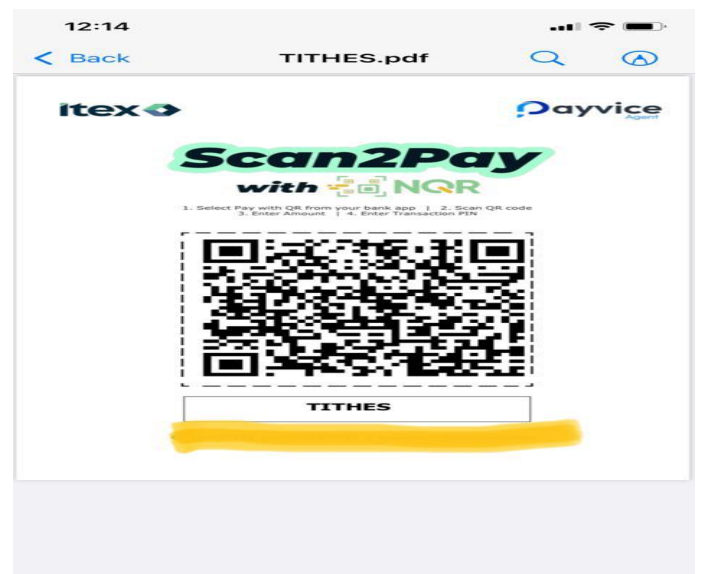

**THEME: HOSPITALITY: NOT OPTIONAL FOR
CHRISTIANS**

**READING: PSALM 145:14-21; NEHEMIAH 6:1-16; 1
PETER 4:7-11; MATTHEW 25:14-30.**

Introduction:

Hospitality is more than welcoming guests, entertaining visitors or providing food and accommodation. Christian hospitality is an expression of love, generosity, service and genuine concern for others. It is the willingness to make room for others in our lives, homes, resources and hearts.

For the Christian, hospitality is part of our Christian calling. Peter writes: "And above all things have fervent love for one another, for 'love will cover a multitude of sins.' Be hospitable to one another without grumbling. As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another, as good stewards of the manifold grace of God" (1 Peter 4:8-10). Hospitality is therefore one of the practical ways we express Christian love and steward the grace God has entrusted to us.

1. HOSPITALITY IS LOVE IN ACTION

It is easy to say, "I love people". Hospitality challenges us to demonstrate that love. It may mean welcoming a stranger, noticing someone who is alone in church, visiting the sick or bereaved, helping a newcomer feel at home, or making room for someone going through a difficult season.

Hospitality says: "You matter. You are welcome. You are not alone". Sometimes, a person may forget the title of a sermon but never forget the person who noticed them, welcomed them and made them feel at home.

2. WHAT GOD HAS GIVEN YOU IS A TRUST

The Parable of the Talents (Matthew 25:14-30) reminds us that what God places in our hands carries responsibility. The servants were entrusted with different resources, and each was expected to use what had been given to him faithfully.

This applies to far more than money. God has entrusted us with homes, time, food, relationships, abilities, possessions, opportunities and spiritual gifts. Hospitality is one way we put these resources to Kingdom use. What God has placed in your hands is not meant to end with you. Hospitality becomes Christian when love, rather than personal gain, is the motivation.

3. HOSPITALITY BEGINS AT HOME

Our hospitality should not begin with strangers while those closest to us feel neglected. A truly hospitable Christian does not merely welcome visitors; he creates an atmosphere of welcome wherever he is. From our



4. WELCOME THOSE WHO CANNOT REPAY YOU

One of the strongest tests of Christian hospitality is how we treat people who have nothing to offer us in return. It is easy to welcome an important person or someone who can advance our interests. But Christlike hospitality reaches beyond convenience and reciprocity.

Jesus teaches us that genuine generosity is not measured only by what we give, but also by whom we are willing to give it to.

5. NEVER UNDERESTIMATE A SIMPLE ACT OF KINDNESS

Hebrews 13:2 says: "Do not forget to entertain strangers, for by so doing some have unwittingly entertained angels".

We do not always know the significance of the person God brings across our path. A visit can become encouragement. A listening ear can become healing. A handshake can communicate acceptance. An open door can become an opportunity for the Gospel. Never underestimate what God can do through a simple act of kindness.

6. HOSPITALITY IS MINISTRY FOR EVERY CHRISTIAN

Peter says: "As each one has received a gift, minister it to one another..." (1 Peter 4:10).

Every Christian can practise it. You may not preach, but you can welcome. You may not lead a ministry, but you can encourage. You may not have great wealth, but you can share what you have. You may not have a position in the church, but you can make somebody feel that they belong.

Hospitality is ministry without a pulpit.

Hospitality is not optional for the Christian because love is not optional for the Christian. God has welcomed us into His family through Christ; therefore, those who have experienced His grace should extend that grace to others.

Open your heart — see people beyond their appearance, status or usefulness.

Open your hands — share the resources God has entrusted to you.

Open your home — create opportunities for fellowship, encouragement and service.

Open your eyes — notice the lonely, the stranger, the newcomer, the grieving and the needy around you.

Open your life — allow God to use you as an instrument of His love.

Let our homes be known for welcome, our churches for love, and our lives for generosity. May we faithfully steward every gift, opportunity and resource entrusted to us, remembering Peter's charge:
