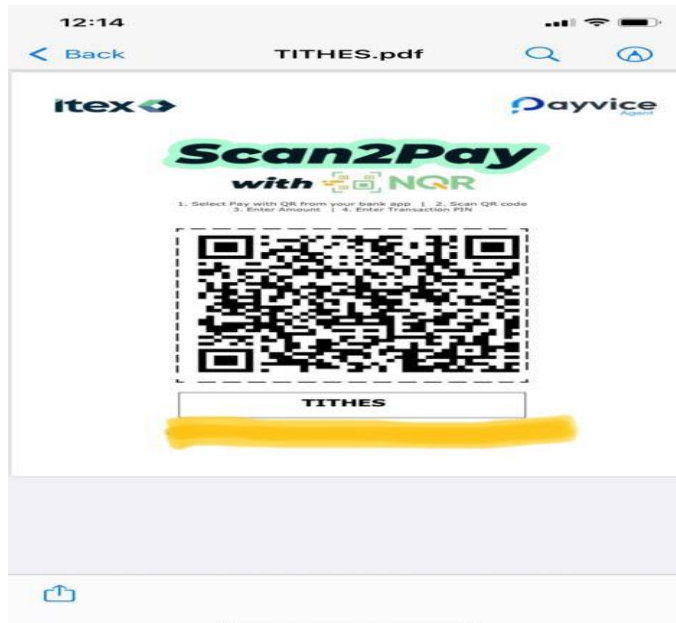

5. **THOUGHT FOR THE WEEK
SUNDAY, 6TH SEPTEMBER, 2026**

**THEME: THE GOOD SAMARITAN PARABLE
AND ITS MESSAGE**

READING: PSALM 119:161-176; LEVITICUS 19:33-37; 1 CORINTHIANS 13:1-13; LUKE 10:25-37.

The parable starts with a man who is an expert in religious law. He asks Jesus, "What must I do to have eternal life?" Jesus asks him what the Scriptures say, and the man answers correctly: love God with everything you have, and love your neighbor as yourself.

Then the man asks another question: "Who is my neighbor?"

This wasn't an honest question. The man was trying to find a way out. He wanted to know exactly who he had to love, so he could stop caring about everyone else. A lot of us think this way too. We want clear limits on our kindness so we don't have to give more than necessary.

The Story Jesus Tells

The Injured Man

- A man is traveling on a dangerous road
- Robbers attack him, take his things, and leave him badly hurt
- We don't know who he is, rich or poor, this group or that group. He's just a person in need

The Ones Who Walked Past

- A priest sees him and walks by without helping
- A religious teacher (a Levite) does the same
- Both men had religious duties, but Jesus doesn't make excuses for them. He just says plainly—they didn't help

The Samaritan Who Stopped

- A Samaritan comes along. Samaritans and Jews did not get along, they saw each other as enemies
- But this man stops. He feels compassion
- He cleans the man's wounds, puts him on his own animal, brings him to a safe place, and pays for everything himself

Why a Samaritan?

Jesus could have picked anyone to be the hero of the story. Instead, he picked someone the Jewish people looked down on. This was on purpose.

By making the "enemy" the one who shows real love, Jesus breaks apart the way the religious teacher was thinking. That man wanted to know: who deserves my love?

Jesus flips the question. At the end, he asks: "Which of these three acted like a neighbor?"

Do you see the difference? The man wanted to know who he was required to love. Jesus asks who actually showed love. The real question isn't "who deserves my kindness?" It's "am I willing to help whoever is in front of me?"

The Message

Love doesn't ask questions first. The Samaritan didn't care who the hurt man was. He just saw someone in need and helped.

Real love takes action. The Samaritan didn't just feel bad for the man, he stopped, used his own supplies, and spent his own money. Love that costs nothing isn't much love at all.

Going to church doesn't equal loving people. The priest and the teacher were the "religious" ones, yet they failed to help. The outsider did what was right. What matters is a heart that acts, not just religious knowledge.

We don't get to pick our neighbor. Jesus doesn't give a neat definition of "neighbour." Instead, he gives a command: "Go and do the same." Whoever is in need in front of us, that person is our neighbor.

Conclusion

The real question isn't "who is my neighbor?" It's "Am I being a neighbor to the people around me?" There are hurting people all around us, some who look different from us, some who make us uncomfortable, some we might rather avoid. Jesus gives us the same instruction he gave that man long ago: go, and do the same.

Let's ask God to help us see people who are hurting, to have hearts willing to stop, and hands ready to help, no matter who they are. Amen.
